



How to get to UWE Enterprise Park (EP1)

The Enterprise Park (EP1) is located on UWE's Frenchay Campus.

Please consider the environmental impact of your journey and come to our conference by public transport if you can.

The venue is a 30-minute walk or a five-minute drive from Bristol Parkway train station.

You can also come via Filton Abbey Wood station, but the walking route is less well-lit and there isn't a taxi rank.

The Frenchay campus is also served by many buses, including the Metro Bus Service.

If you do choose to drive, the Frenchay Campus is near the M4, M5 and M32 motorways. Please note that if you are driving, access to EP1 is only permitted via the West Entrance.

Free shuttle bus service from Bristol Parkway Station

To encourage delegates to come by train, we have organised a free shuttle bus service from Bristol Parkway Station to EP1, which will run every 10 minutes from 9am to 10am.

The shuttle will run again at the end of the day, taking delegates back to the station from 4pm to 5pm.

Taxis from Bristol Parkway Station

The taxi rank at Bristol Parkway is by the main entrance. If you require an accessible taxi, please approach a member of station staff.

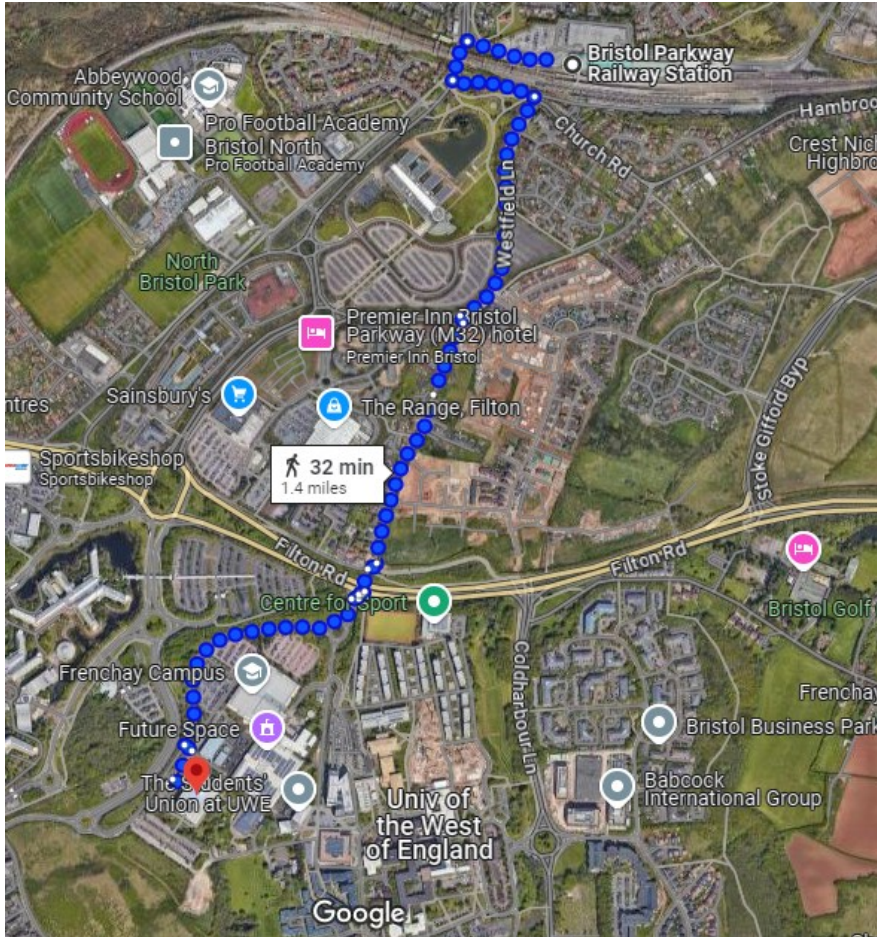
The taxi ride to UWE Enterprise Park (EP1) should take around five minutes.

Please tell your taxi driver that access is **only permitted via the West Entrance** (do not go via the North Entrance). For further information, you can share the driving instructions below with your driver.

Walking from Bristol Parkway Station

It takes just over 30 minutes to walk from Bristol Parkway to the venue.

- Head out of Parkway station, past the car park on your right and at the first roundabout take the first exit left onto Hatchet Road, following signs for UWE.
- At the next roundabout, turn left and walk along Church Road.
- At the next roundabout, turn right onto Westfield Lane.
- Continue along here until just before Westfield Lane becomes Great Stoke Way. Take the turning on the left here for Harry Stoke Road.
- Follow this road until you reach a mini roundabout.
- Take the pedestrian walkway through to the main road (Filton Road) and a set of traffic lights. Cross the road here.
- UWE North Gate is directly opposite the traffic lights.
- At the roundabout after the security barrier, take the second exit to the right and follow the road, passing car parks 23, 22 and 21 on your right.
- Take the fourth road on your left to enter the EP1 car park. You'll see the venue entrance ahead of you on the right.

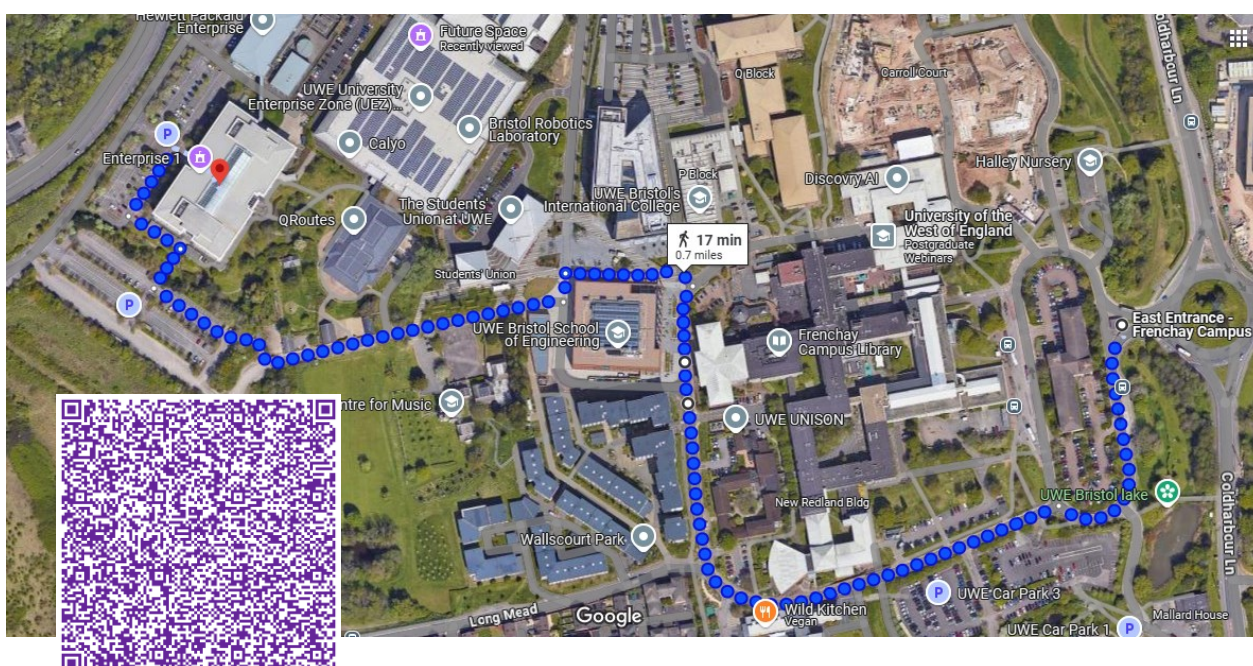
By bus

Many bus services stop at UWE's Frenchay Campus, including the Metro Bus Service (M1 and M3). For a full list, [visit the Travelwest website](#).

Most buses set down at the UWE East Entrance. From here it's a 15 to 20-minute walk through the campus to the Enterprise Park (EP1).

Walking directions from the East Entrance bus stops to EP1

[Here is a recommended walking route from the East Entrance to EP1 on Google Maps.](#)



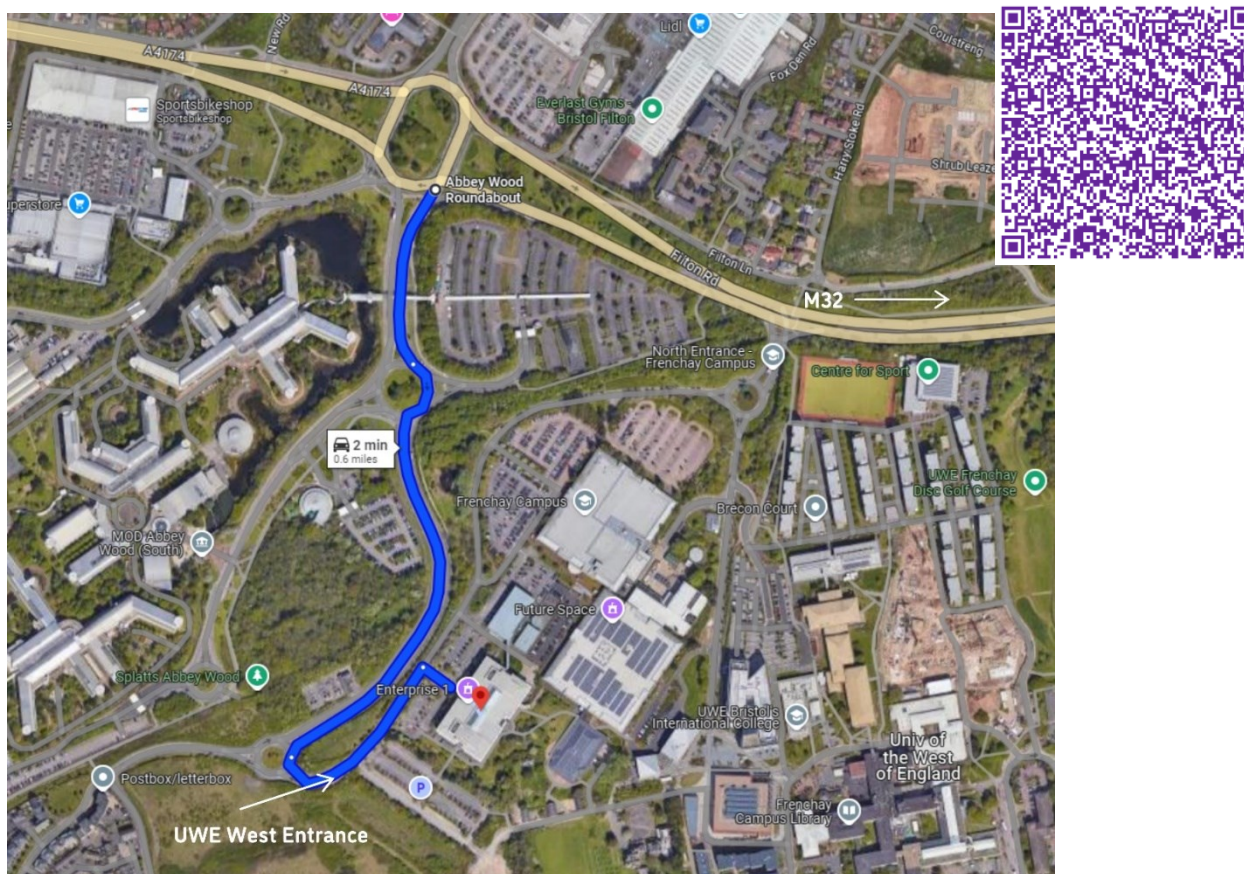
- Head left when leaving the bus.
- Walk straight up the hill, following the pavement round to the right and bear to the right again before Long Mead.
- After the School of Engineering (rusty building), take the path to the left. Bristol Business School (grey building) will be on your left.
- Follow the path down the hill, passing the Student's Union on your right.
- Continue along this path until you see a right-hand turn into a car park.
- Walk through the car park to the front of the building on your right. This is the Enterprise Park (EP1).

By car

If you are driving to the conference, please make sure you follow these directions carefully.

Entrance by car is only permitted via the West Entrance of UWE. Do not drive in through the North or East entrances.

- From the A4174 / Filton Road, exit the Abbey Wood Roundabout, following signs for HP Estate and MOD reception & car parks.
- Move into the middle lane.
- At the next roundabout, go straight over, taking the second exit signposted Cheswick HP Estate.
- Follow the road round to the right and at the next roundabout, take the first exit to the left, signposted HP Estate.
- This is the West Entrance to UWE. Pass through the security barrier and the entrance to the EP1 car park is the second on your right, signposted Visitor Parking & Reception.

If EP1 car park is full...

We have arranged to use Car Park 21 as an overflow car park. Normally this is pay-and-display, but we have permission to use it on the day of our event so you will not need to pay to use it and you can ignore the signs.

To get to Car Park 21, turn right from the EP1 entrance out of the car park and follow this road. You'll soon see the sign for Car Park 21 – see map below.
